The Laker Hockey Locker Room stalls/lockers, dry lockers, stick storage area and coaches’ white board area date back to 1995 and are in need of replacement after 25 years of wear and tear. The locker room is an important recruiting tool to showcase for recruits and their parents. The room provides an important inner sanctum for the coaches and a positive environment for the team. Our goal is to have the project completed this summer.
